## Sport and Recreation in Baw Baw Shire

Baw Baw Shire has a broad mixture of sporting and recreational facilities, which includes a balance between active and passive recreation.

Council provides the following recreation services to the community:

- Aquatic and leisure centres
- Reserves/sporting fields (facility hiring services)
- Halls and pavilions
- Grant schemes
- Facility development

#### **Recreation Facilities**

Baw Baw Shire Council has leisure facilities in Warragul and Drouin including the Warragul Leisure Centre and Bellbird Park. Council also provides outdoor summer pools in Trafalgar, Drouin, Thorpdale and Neerim South.

#### Sporting Reserves and Halls

Baw Baw Shire has over 20 recreation reserves with facilities that cater for a wide variety of sports. These facilities are managed by Council, Crown Committees of Management or Council Section 86 Committees of Management.

#### Two Towns Trail

The Two Towns Trail is an eight kilometre shared path connecting Warragul and Drouin. Features of the trail include wetlands, interpretive signage, pause places with chairs and bike racks, remnant stands of vegetation, boardwalks, views to Camp Hill and the Baw Baw ranges to the north and Mt Worth and the Strzelecki Ranges to the south.
