

## Schedule of fees - Tree Maintenance

Current costs as of 1 August 2023

When it comes to the location of your crossover (driveway access) please consider the following costs, you as the homeowner, will be charged to have a street tree either transplanted, removed, or replaced.

Depending on the type and size of the tree in question, these costs may increase. This is typical if the street tree is greater than 3m in height.

Payment of the invoice will be required after an assessment has been completed. Any works required relating to the tree will only be actioned by Council's Infrastructure Maintenance team. The Infrastructure Maintenance will inspect the site and determine the required standard for the street tree and costs associated with the works required will be determined using the table below.

Council Standard	Cost inc GST \$
Transplantation and relocation	390
Removed and not replaced due to assets within nature strip or reduced nature strip length	200
Removal of tree and replaced in Autumn	710

These costs are indicative of a two-year maintenance/management plan that includes watering, mulching, weed control and formative pruning of the trees by Council.
