

Volunteering Opportunities

Baw Baw Shire Council has a range of volunteering opportunities available with the Home and Community Care Service. Contact Council's Volunteer Officer on 5624 2411 for further information or to express your interest.

Meals on Wheels

Volunteers deliver meals to clients in Drouin, Warragul, Neerim South or Trafalgar. Volunteers deliver meals with a partner, taking about one and half hours on their day of preference.

Community Shopping Bus

Volunteer driver and jockey pick up clients using the Baw Baw HACC Community bus and transport them to shopping facilities. Clients and volunteers then meet for lunch before returning home. This activity occurs fortnightly and is a full day per fortnight.

Friendly Visiting Program

Volunteers are matched with a client who is looking for some companionship. Visits may occur weekly, fortnightly or monthly depending on the availability of the volunteer and the wishes of the client. This is an opportunity to develop a friendship with someone who shares similar values and interests.

Pet Program

Volunteers assist clients with walking of dogs, grooming and the transport of pets to the vet.

Community Transport

Volunteers assist clients with transport to their medical appointments either locally, regionally or to Melbourne depending on their preference. Volunteer drivers will receive reimbursement towards their expenses.

PAG (Planned Day Activities)

Volunteers assist with preparing lunch for clients, craft activities and participate in outings with the group. This activity is a full day each week.

Gardening Program

Light gardening duties, watering, weeding, sweeping/raking weeds, potting plants, light pruning are some of the duties undertaken by our volunteers.

Administration Support

Assist with mail outs for newsletters and other administration duties as required.
