# **Education Sponsorship 2020**

Eligible education providers can nominate up to two students from Year 9, 10, 11 or 12, or aged between 15-21 years to receive a \$250 (inc GST) cash award and certificate. All students are eligible for the first award. The second award is for a student who is Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander. Applications can be made in September/October for a November/ December presentation.

## **Encouraging further learning in Baw Baw**

Baw Baw Shire Council's Education Sponsorship aims to encourage students in Year 9 and over (or aged between 15 -21 years) in their preferred education pathway by supporting local education providers with an opportunity to recognise and acknowledge attributes and effort.

Nominees will be outstanding in two or more of these qualities:

- Authentic
- Pragmatic
- Respectful

- Optimistic
- Supportive

Education Sponsorship is a stream of Council's Community Financial Assistance Program that has invested over \$600,000 in 2019/20. It supports local secondary- and pathway-education providers to recognise and financially award students who meet the eligibility criteria.

Students in mainstream, specialist or pathway education are eligible for nomination. Education providers may apply for a second award for an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander student who meets the same criteria.

These education providers are eligible to apply in 2020:

### Preferences for nominated students

Eligible students will preferably be Baw Baw Shire residents.

### What's involved?

**Apply online:** Eligible education providers make an application in September/October to Baw Baw Shire Council using an online system called *SmartyGrants*.

**Assessment**: A panel of Councillors and officers, including the Youth Officer assess the application and make a recommendation. Information will be provided in writing to the applicant.

**Receiving and giving funds:** Successful applicants invoice Council for the funds. The applicant provides the student with funds.

**Presenting Awards**: Councillors will strive to attend the presentation event and be available to present the award at a November/December event.

### When can I apply?

The round will be opened 14 September and will close 16 October 2020.
