## Documents

Where applicable, the owner of an animal must produce proof of sterilisation, microchip implant, membership of approved association, obedience papers, breeding license, statutory declaration or tax return proof of working dog status.

## Excess Animal Permits

Permits must be obtained to keep more than two dogs and/or two cats per residential household.

## Pensioner Concessions

If you currently hold an eligible pension card you are entitled to a 50 per cent reduction in registration fees (excluding restricted breed dogs and declared dangerous/menacing dogs). Please present your card in person at the time of renewal.

**Please note health care card holders are not entitled to registration discount.**

## Privacy

The personal information requested on this form is being collected by Council for the enforcement and administration of animal control in accordance with the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*. The personal information will be used by Council and/or its contractors for that primary purpose or as directly required to by law. The applicant may apply to Council for access and/or amendment of the information.

## State Government Levy

Your animal registration fees include the State Government Levy of \$3.50 for dog registration and/or \$2.00 for cat registration. This is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership education programs.

## Replacement Animal ID

Replacement animal ID markers (tag) can be obtained from any Customer Service Centre free of charge.

## Restricted Breed Dogs Declaration

The *Domestic Animals Act 1994* requires specific controls for the keeping of restricted breed dogs. The Victorian Government has made legislation to restrict the following dog breeds:

- **American Pit Bull Terrier**
- **Dogo Argentino**
- **Fila Brasileiro**
- **Japanese Tosa**
- **Perro de Presa Canario**
- **Pit Bull Terrier**
