

Fenced dog park at Brooker Park Warragul



Construction will soon start on a fully fenced dog park at Brooker Park in Warragul. The site will be approximately 5000m² located in the central park area. Works are expected to start in April and be completed by mid-2020. Fenced dog parks will also be constructed in Bellbird Park Drouin and Hollydell Park Trafalgar (formerly Linear Reserve).

What will the dog park include?



Air lock gate entry
Double gate with landing area for safe entry and exit from the fenced area.



All weather footpath connection from the existing path



Signage
Wayfinding signage at Sutton Street, Bowen Street and Charles Street entry points.



Doggy drinking fountain
To make it easy to stay hydrated.



Doggy waste bag dispenser and bin
For easy, convenient and responsible clean up after your dog.



Seating
For dog owners to use and enjoy.



Tree plantings
To provide shade in warmer months and break up the wide open space.



Maintenance access gates
To allow for routine maintenance and waste collections.



Soccer goals
Relocation of one set to the existing oval
