

Thank you for booking your hard waste collection. Please follow the instructions below to ensure that you are putting out hard waste correctly.





Place items in a neat pile on your nature strip on the weekend immediately before the collection week. Items must not be placed out any earlier than seven days before your scheduled collection week. Please note, your hard waste cannot be more than two cubic metres and each item should be easily lifted by two people. Materials over two cubic metres will not be collected. Please note, carpet must be rolled and tied (a maximum of one roll that can be lifted by one person).

If all of your items are removed by scavengers before your collection week, please call the contractor on 1800 969 278 during office hours, Monday to Friday, 8am to 5.30pm to cancel the booking and avoid losing your collection entitlement.
