








# Warragul Parking Study



## Project timeline

Baw Baw Shire Council is undertaking a thorough review of car parking in Warragul. The purpose of this study is not to determine if more car parks are needed, but how solutions can be made that are both practical and financially viable. Council will work closely with the community across all stages of the study to understand sentiments and desired outcomes. This initial community consultation period is now open, **closing on Wednesday 10 June 2020.**

### Timeline

- 1** Feb-Jun 2020   
**Community consultation 'Have Your Say' survey and workshops**  
Community members are invited to provide their feedback via an online and hard copy survey. Several community workshops will also be held for residents to find out more information, ask questions and provide feedback.
- 2** June 2020   
**Collate and review community feedback**  
Council officers will consolidate all feedback collected during the consultation period. An update will be provided to the community on the outcomes.
- 3** Jun-Jul 2020   
**Community panel appointment**  
To ensure fair and adequate representation of various community views and input, an independent panel will also be recruited comprising of a representative cross section of the community. The panel will assist to provide recommendations to Council.
- 4** Jul-Sep 2020   
**Panel deliberation/recommendations**  
Council officers will work with the panel to deliberate recommendations for parking in Warragul, including a potential funding model. Recommendations will be reviewed and presented to Council for feedback at a briefing.
- 5** Sep 2020   
**Council decision**  
A recommendation will be presented to Council for decision at a Council meeting. The meeting will be open to the community with all residents welcome to attend.

### Online workshop dates

Online workshops are open to all community members to discuss key options up for consideration, ask questions and provide feedback. All workshops will be held online to comply with COVID-19 social distancing requirements.
