

Neerim South Wetlands

The Neerim South Wetland is located to the south-east of the town centre.

Once a weed infested paddock, the wetlands which opened in 2015 now provide a community recreation space with environmental benefits. The wetlands are used as a sustainable water supply for irrigation of the Neerim South Recreation Reserve and Secondary College grounds to the north of the site.

Vehicle access to the wetland is via Railway Road. Bus parking is available along Railway Road, with vehicle parking (including disabled parking) located on Birdsong Rise.

A walking track along Red Hill Creek connects the wetlands back to the town centre via Neerim East Road.

A toilet, BBQ shelter and interpretive signage is provided at the site.
