Attitudes

76% 92%

Sixteen per cent more people said they were more confident to report crime to the Police (before 76%; after 92%)

66% 84%

Eighteen per cent more people said they **knew where to find good information** (before 66%; after 84%)

74% 88%

Fourteen per cent more people said they were **confident to talk** with trusted people about home security. (before 74%; after 88%)

Behaviours

Of twelve favourable behaviours that all showed improvement, over 50 per cent of people had done more in these six areas:

- Made friendly social connections with neighbours
 - Moved keys tools and valuables to more secure locations.
 - Thought about the area outside of their home to see if it could be made safer
 - Inspected their **door and window locks** and limiters to see how secure they are
 - Tried to make their home appear occupied when they are not at home
 - Contact with trusted family and friends
