Boasting more than \$46 million in the year 2025/26, our Capital Works Program provides community facilities, assets, and infrastructure to service the current and emerging needs of our community.

We are so excited to present to you a suite of exciting projects, some of which are already underway and due for completion, and others that we're looking forward to making a start on.

This year you will see major streetscaping, road upgrades, refurbished playgrounds and Council buildings, tree planting, public lighting renewal, toilet block and footpath upgrades and so much more.

This year's draft budget is economically responsible and positions Council to deliver an exciting array of projects, services, and infrastructure for our rapidly growing community.

Plan:

- Facility Renewals: \$1.65 million
- Loch Street Footpath, Yarragon: \$0.32 million
- Rollo Street Masterplan Project, Yarragon: \$600,000

2025/26 infrastructure project highlights:

Baw Baw Cultural Connection Precinct (Stage 1)

 Works will begin in early 2026 for an exciting new library and community hub at the corner of Civic Place and Albert Street in Warragul.

The project is set to be delivered over three financial years: 2025/26, 2026/27 and 2027/28.

Warragul Leisure Water Heating Electrification: \$1.1 million

Subject to a successful grant application, Council plans to upgrade the Warragul Leisure
Centre to help reduce energy costs. This includes switching the pool systems to electric
and making the most of the new solar panels installed during the recent stadium
expansion. A further \$1.1 million is allocated in 2026/2027, taking the total project cost to
\$2.2 million over the two years.

Sealed Roads Renewals: \$4.7 million

• Roads across the shire will see an increased investment towards road resealing, road reconstruction and the repair of localised pavement repairs.

Copelands Road Warragul upgrade: \$3 million

 Copelands Road, Warragul will benefit from major roadworks as part of Council's Road Reconstruction Program. The upgrades are proposed to be completed by late 2025 and open to the public.

Drouin Streetscape Works: \$1.6 million

 Streetscape improvement works will take place along Commercial Place, Drouin, including improvements to the laneways between Princes Way and Commercial Place.
 The works will kick off at the end of 2025 and are expected to be finished in 2026.
